“Getting on with our Lives?”

A study of the experiences of people who use equipment for “independent living” was published in 2005 as a result of a review of the Co-operative Bank's Disability Fund, set up to support people who require such equipment. The Government has now announced its intention to reconfigure equipment services and to move towards a retail model. This seminar will explore the implications of the reforms and ways in which disabled people's requirements and expectations can be more fully met in the future.
