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Please use Gift Aid and make your donations to Disabled Living go further by completing this declaration. As a charity we can claim Gift Aid tax relief of 25p on every pound you give.

HMRC will also be operating transitional provisions for Gift Aid donations made from 6 April 2008 until 5 April 2011, paying a supplement of 3p on every pound you give. Therefore Disabled Living will continue to receive an additional 28p per £1 donated e.g. for every £10 given we can claim an extra £2.82.

Please note:

3. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief via your Self Assessment tax return (currently 25p for each pound you give)**
4. Please notify Disabled Living if you change your name or address.

* Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which allows charities after 6 April 2008 to reclaim 25 pence on the pound. HMRC will pay a supplement of 3 pence on every pound donated until 5th April 2011. Disabled Living will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.

** Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate tax
